

Prep one per student:

Background paper 9 x 12 {I used green, red, yellow, black}

Crust template {copied on brown}

Cheese template {copied on yellow}

1 1/2 x 12 inch strips {red, green, black, light brown}

I demonstrated how to make the topping and then students worked on their own.

*pepperoni-cut the red strip into squares, cut off all 4 corners and trim into circles.

*peppers-cut the green into rectangles than cut a rainbow shape.

*olives-follow the steps for pepperoni, then fold in half and cut a semi-circle, open and the middle will be cut out.

*mushrooms-draw an oval and rectangle on light brown, cut out and turn over so the pencil marks don't show.

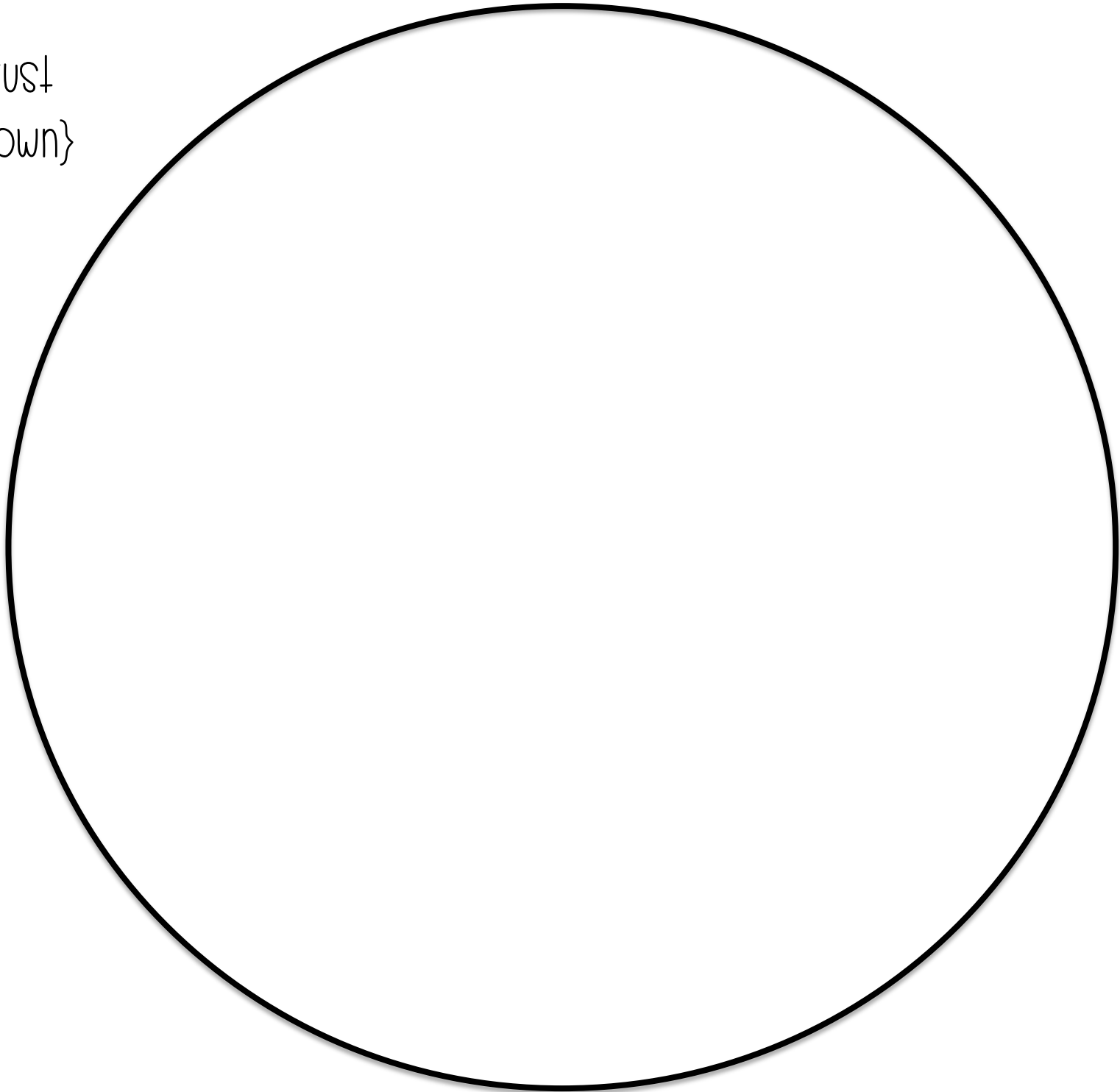

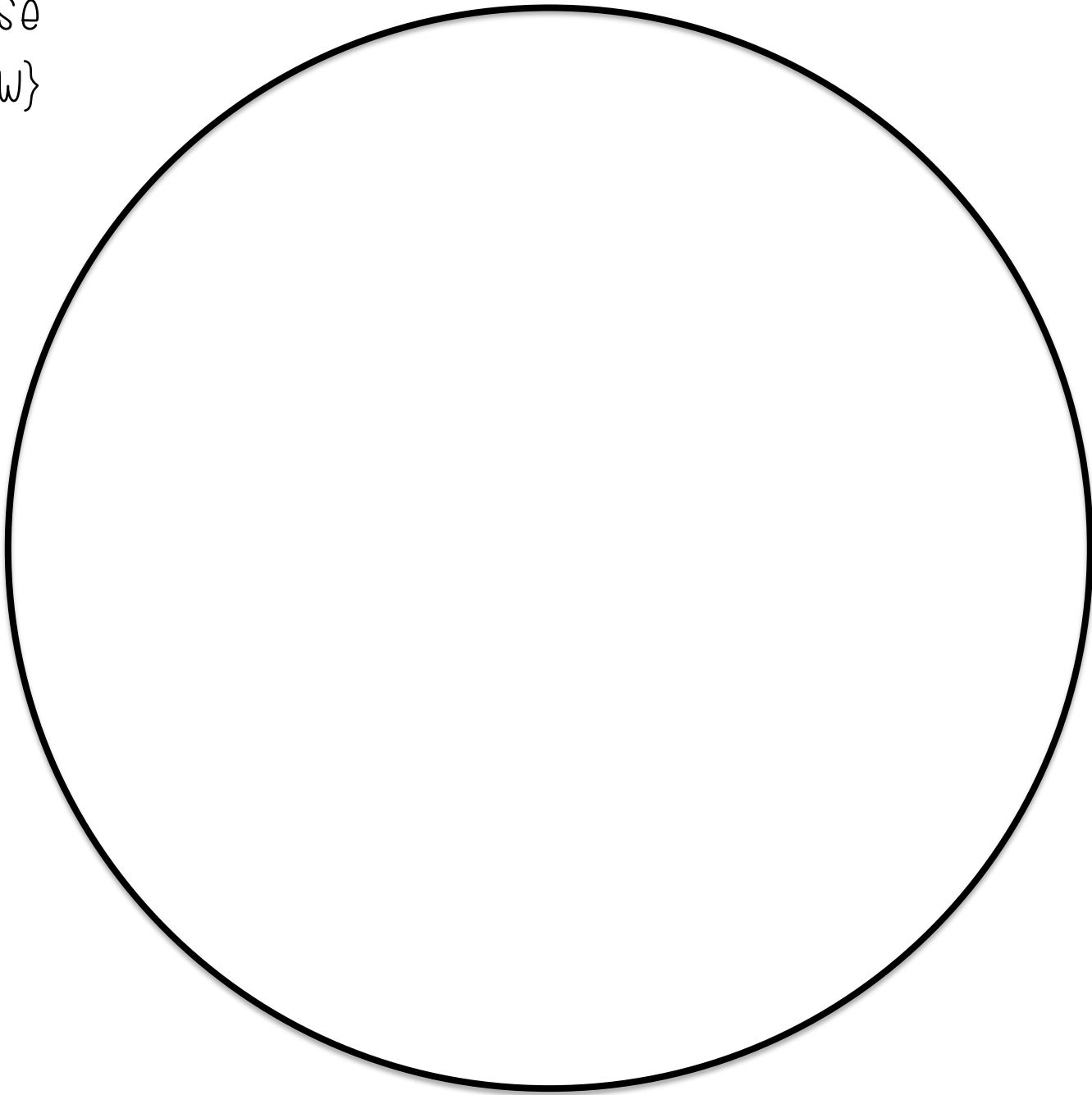
